

WHEREAS gerrymandering is a partisan process of redistricting state and federal offices to assure election outcomes and

WHEREAS gerrymandering is improper when done by any single political party or political organization and

WHEREAS this process is said to allow representatives to pick their voters rather than allowing voters to pick their representatives and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin State Legislature has the responsibility to redistrict legislative boundaries every 10 years according to the number of inhabitants defined by the U.S. Census count and

WHEREAS, there is need to restore trust, compromise and fair competition in Wisconsin politics.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Juneau County Board of Supervisors advocates that the Wisconsin State Legislature create a fair, nonpartisan, transparent procedure for preparing State Legislative and Congressional districts following the 2030 federal census; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Juneau County Board of Supervisors advocate for an amendment to the Wisconsin Constitution giving the responsibility of legislative redistricting to a nonpartisan commission; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Juneau County Clerk is directed to send a copy of this resolution to the Governor and Legislature of the State of Wisconsin.
