**WHEREAS** gerrymandering is a partisan process of redistricting state and federal offices to assure election outcomes and

**WHEREAS** gerrymandering is improper when done by any single political party or political organization and

**WHEREAS** this process is said to allow representatives to pick their voters rather than allowing voters to pick their representatives and

**WHEREAS**, the Wisconsin State Legislature has the responsibility to redistrict legislative boundaries every 10 years according to the number of inhabitants defined by the U.S. Census count and

**WHEREAS**, there is need to restore trust, compromise and fair competition in Wisconsin politics.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Juneau County Board of Supervisors advocates that the Wisconsin State Legislature create a fair, nonpartisan, transparent procedure for preparing State Legislative and Congressional districts following the 2030 federal census; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Juneau County Board of Supervisors advocate for an amendment to the Wisconsin Constitution giving the responsibility of legislative redistricting to a nonpartisan commission; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Juneau County Clerk is directed to send a copy of this resolution to the Governor and Legislature of the State of Wisconsin.
